In this role the Pharmacist must be able demonstrate a high level of self-initiative to successfully perform all essential functions, duties, tasks, assignments, and responsibilities for the successful administration and management of the pharmacy. As a Licensed Pharmacist, the Pharmacist will also be responsible for all of the essential functions, responsibilities, and authority of a Pharmacist. Such as dispensing medications, drugs prescribed by physicians and other health care practitioners, and provide counseling and deliver information to patients about the medications and their use.
